The Rio Grande Globe Amaranth is an annual plant of the Amaranthaceae family, which can reach 60cm.

Its globular flowers are composed of dry, odorless scales and do no wither.

Cultivation

Likes airy soil, with sun exposure and rich in organic matter.

It is easily multiplied by seed at any time of the year.

It should be watered daily in the hottest season and in the winter whenever the soil is dry.

History

Utilization

In medicine, it is often used to relieve cough and hoarseness.
